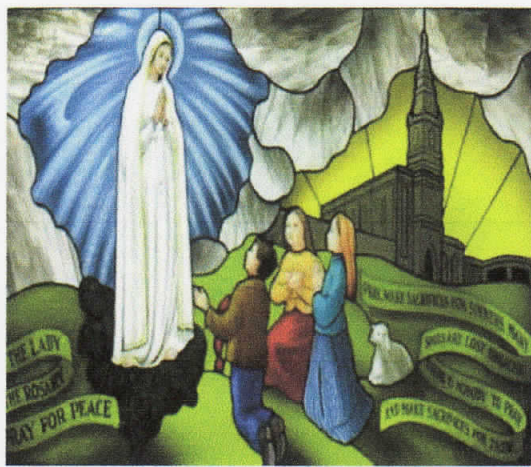
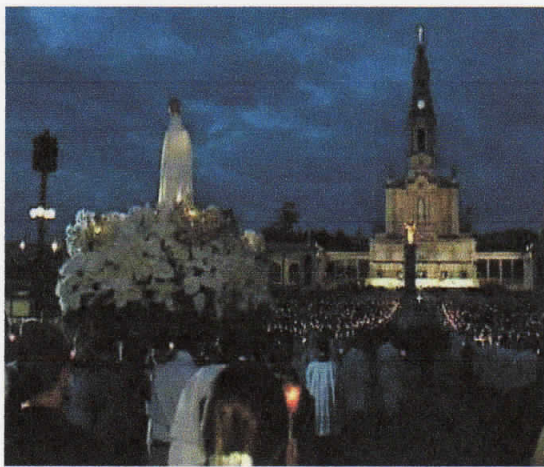


# OUR LADY OF FATIMA PILGRIMAGE

**June 17, 2010 / Thursday:** Our Pilgrimage to Fatima begins as we depart Denver International Airport for our overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

**June 18 / Friday:** Upon arrival into Lisbon International Airport we'll be met by our Portuguese Escort who will be our guide during our visit to Portugal. While in Lisbon, we will visit the birth place of St. Anthony where our chaplain will celebrate Mass for us in thanksgiving of our safe arrival. Next, we will take a guided tour of this beautiful port city followed by our motor-coach transfer to Fatima. Following dinner we'll all head to the shrine for our first candle light procession.

**June 19 / Saturday:** Today we will visit the shrine of Our Lady of Fatima and the Capelinha, the site where our Blessed Mother appeared to the Fatima Children. Our chaplain will celebrate Mass for us in the Basilica. In the afternoon, we'll walk together through Aljustrel, Valinhos, and the Loca Do Cabeco. Tonight we'll all head to the shrine for the nightly candle light procession.

**June 20 / Sunday:** Today we will depart Fatima for an excursion to visit the walled city of Obidos. Obidos is something out of a story book with beautiful quaint streets. The old town center is surrounded by castle walls, battlemented and reinforced by towers. Within these walls are picturesque whitewashed Renaissance and Baroque houses, most of them covered with flowers.

**June 21 / Monday:** This morning we'll drive northward to the Carmelite convent, once residence of Sr. Lucia, in Coimbra. Here we'll also venerate the relics of Queen St. Elizabeth. In the afternoon, we will return to Fatima, where we'll have an opportunity to spend leisure time.



**June 22 / Tuesday:** Mass at the Basilica. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. You may want to walk the stations one more time or pray at the Capelinha. Tonight we'll all head to the shrine for the nightly candle light procession.

**June 23 / Wednesday:** Today we will visit the Atlantic coast, the beaches, and, the markets of Nazare. We will also visit the



Medieval town of Batalha with its mighty church and the Abbey of Alcobaca. Tonight we will gather for our farewell diner.

**June 24 / Thursday:** With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we'll board our plane for the return flight home.
